

## Framing Australia's Wildlife Competition

The Framing Australia's Wildlife Competition is an opportunity for Sunshine Coast youth to showcase their artistic talents by capturing through drawing or painting, Australia's native wildlife. All proceeds from entry fees go directly to the Australian Wildlife Hospital, which cares for over 5,500 sick and injured patients every year! Funds will go towards a brand new Hospital which is almost finished construction. The new Hospital will have the scope to care for up to 10,000 patients annually! The Framing Australia's Wildlife Competition is an initiative of Complete Framing Maroochydore and Noosa stores and is supported by Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors Worldwide Ltd.

### Eligibility

In order to enter the Framing Australia's Wildlife Competition you must be:

- Youth aged 4-17 years of age; and
- A resident of the Sunshine Coast.

### Categories

There are four categories for entry:

1. Age group 4 to 7 years
2. Age group 8 to 10 years
3. Age group 11 to 13 years
4. Age group 14 to 17 years

### Prizes

Prizes will be provided to the winners of each age group including:

- Winning artwork will be framed by Complete Framing
- Family Pass to Australia Zoo on Steve Irwin Day (15 November 2008) (date not transferable)
- A signed photo with Bindi Irwin framed with artwork (subject to availability)
- VIP tour of the brand new Australian Wildlife Hospital
- Framed Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors certificate
- Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors gift pack

Weekly prize will be drawn randomly and awarded to a competition entrant every week:

- \$50 Complete Framing gift voucher to be redeemed at Complete Framing Maroochydore and Noosa stores only.

School class prize given to the school of the winning entrant in each category:

- Framed photo of the Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors crew.

### Terms and Conditions

- The competition is called "Framing Australia's Wildlife" and is run to raise funds for the Australian Wildlife Hospital, a major project of Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors Worldwide Ltd.
- The competition opens **Friday 15 August 2008** and closes on **Friday 31 October 2008**. Entry forms, entry fee, artwork description and artwork must be received by **5:00pm on Friday 31 October**.
- Major prize winners in each category will be announced on **Friday 7 November 2008** via phone and email.
- The competition is run in partnership with Complete Framing Maroochydore and Noosa stores, Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors Worldwide Ltd and Australia Zoo.

- Entrants are permitted to submit unlimited entries; however each entry will attract an entry fee of \$2.
- \$2 entry fee will be donated to Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors in aid of the Australian Wildlife Hospital.
- Entries are to be in the following medium: drawing or painting. Pastels, lead pencil and charcoal medium must be sealed prior to entry.
- The competition is open to school age children (aged 4 to 17 years), living and/or attending school in the area covered by the Sunshine Coast Regional Council.
- Employees and their immediate families of Complete Framing Noosa, Complete Framing Maroochydore, Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors and Australia Zoo are ineligible to enter. Employees and their immediate families of co-promoters are also ineligible to enter.
- Entries that do not contain an original entry form will not be considered a valid entry.
- Entries are restricted to maximum A3 paper size.
- Entrant must be accompanied by a parent/guardian when entering the competition.
- All entries will only be accepted at Complete Framing Noosa or Complete Framing Maroochydore Studios.
- Official entry forms are available from Complete Framing Noosa and Maroochydore stores or online at [www.sunshinecoastpictureframing.com.au](http://www.sunshinecoastpictureframing.com.au).
- An entry registration number will be provided to parent/guardian of entrant upon entry.
- Complete Framing will need to collect information about the entrant and their parent/guardian in order to include the entry in the competition.
- Entrants must include their name, age, address, parent/guardian email, telephone number (daytime and after hours) and school currently attending with their entry.
- Complete Framing may also share your information with other persons or entities which assist in running this competition or with the other companies who provide prizes for this competition.
- Promoter, Complete Framing Noosa, Complete Framing Maroochydore, Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors and Australia Zoo and their employees and agents shall not be liable for any loss or damage to the entry however so caused, but will undertake all due care in the storage of the entry
- The four (4) major prize winners and their schools, together with the weekly prize winners will be notified by telephone and/or by email.
- The winning artworks will be selected via a judging panel consisting of local well known identities.
- Each entry will be numbered at the time of entry. Judging is by entry numbers only.
- Judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Entries remain the property of Complete

Framing until the winners are announced on **Friday 7 November 2008**.

- Entries will be kept at Complete Framing Maroochydore and Noosa stores until **noon 31 January 2009** and may be collected by entrant up until this time.
- Winners will need to provide proof of identity upon collection of prize (proof of identity includes entry registration number and parent/guardian drivers license).
- Proof of entry (entry registration number) will be required upon collection of artwork.

### Prize details:

- Each age group winner will receive their artwork framed including an engraved plaque on the frame, a signed photo of Bindi Irwin with the winners (subject to availability), an Australia Zoo Family Pass to enter Australia Zoo on Steve Irwin Day (15 November 2008) (date not transferable), VIP tour for four (4) people of the brand new Australian Wildlife Hospital (on a date mutually agreed by Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors and the winner); a framed Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors certificate and an Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors goody bag.
- The winning entrant of the weekly prize will receive a \$50 Complete Framing voucher to be used at Complete Framing Maroochydore or Noosa stores.
- The school class prize given to the school of the winning entrant in each category will receive a framed photo of the Australia Zoo Wildlife Warriors crew.
